

Graduation Rates

At Brigham Young University graduation rates remain high. According to collegefactual.com, there is a 90% Freshman retention rate in comparison with the national average being at a 68% retention rate. At BYU, there were 7,230 bachelor's degree candidates in the class of 2015. By 2017, six years after beginning their degree, 61.6% of these students had graduated. After an additional two years, 84.8% of this class eventually completed their degree. Many students at BYU take a two- year sabbatical to serve an LDS church mission thus taking longer than 4 years to complete their degree. Graduation rates in the field of education are similar to university graduation rates.
