



CAEP Accountability Standard 4—Initial Programs

Ability of completers to be hired in education positions for which they have been prepared

BYU Educator Preparation Program completers are hired at a high rate. Survey data from responding completers from August 2017 to June 2022 showed only 3.43% of education completers who are seeking a job have not been hired. Those who were hired had a 58.37% hire rate prior to graduation with 11.87% being hired within less than one month from graduation, 20.82 hired 1 to 3 months after graduation, and 8.95 hired within 4 to 6 months after graduation.
